DIRECTIONS TO VENUE:

From Newton Abbot - take the A381 towards Totnes. After about 6½ miles you will see a Brown sign on your right to Mare & Foal Sanctuary, with the turning on your left. Follow this lane for a short way and The Mare & Foal Sanctuary is on your right.

From Totnes - take the A381 towards Newton Abbot. After about 2 miles you will see a pub on your left (the Pig and Whistle). Shortly after that you will see a Brown sign on your left to the Mare & Foal Sanctuary, with the turning on your right. Follow this lane for a short way and The Mare & Foal Sanctuary is on your right.

*** LOWER HEIGHT OPTION:**

1. All classes with LHO will have **combined** awards.
2. Once a dog has been entered at the LHO it cannot compete at a different height in any class at this competition.
3. Lower heights are set at 550mm (large dogs).
4. The Lower Height dogs will run **SECOND** in every class. If you are late turning up you will lose your run.
5. There will only be one course walking at the start of the class.

For one entry fee dogs are automatically, without exception, entered in 3 classes agility, jumping & jumping fun.

Class 19 Special Anysize Jumping open to all sizes of dogs not entered in any other class. No weave poles. Jumps will be at medium (45cm), small (35cm) and micro height (25cm) pick your own height on the day, class will start at medium height, please ensure you are at the ring for your run at the correct time. There will only be one course walking at the start of the class.

Wins, places and clear rounds in unaffiliated shows will not count towards agility warrant points or grade progression at Kennel Club or UKA shows.

Dogs can only be entered in one size category i.e.:- Large, LH Large, Medium, or Small.

NOTE: The Small//Medium classes are counted as one Class, but each will compete at their own height.

Silent toys may be used in the rings, but must be used with consideration for other competitors.

JUMPING FUN CLASSES

The Special Jumping Fun classes will be a fun, fast and flowing style and will have no weave poles. Each judge will set one course for all the dogs (regardless of grade or height) competing in their ring. **It is planned that this course will be walked over lunch and will be run in size order, Ring 1 starting with LARGE, Ring 2 starting with Small.**

AWARDS

Trophies- up to 30 entries 1st place, 30 - 50 entries 2nd place, over 50 entries 3rd place. Rosettes at least 10% of entries. Rosettes to all unplaced clear rounds in all classes.

RULES & REGULATIONS:

1. All jump heights will be in line with Kennel Club regulations.
2. Entry fees are **£8.95 per dog, £7.95 for SDA&DTC members (all of whom are expected to help at the show)**
3. Internet entries can be made via the SWAP website www.swap-live.com
4. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
5. Only dogs of 18 calendar months of age and over on the day of competition are eligible for competition.
6. Organisers of an unaffiliated Limited Agility show may set a capping level on the entries to be accepted in any class, and may decline entries received after the capping level has been reached.
7. A dog must not compete more than once in a class.
8. Not For Competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged four calendar months and over.
9. No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
10. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
11. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the competition is forbidden.
12. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar ie. not attached by a ring.
13. Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
14. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.
15. The height limit for dogs in Standard Classes.
 - A. Large Dog classes - For dogs measuring over 430mm (1ft 5ins) at the withers.
 - B. Medium Dog classes - For dogs measuring over 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) and measuring 430mm (1ft 5ins) or under at the withers.
 - C. Small Dog classes - For dogs measuring 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) or under at the withers
16. Judges may not enter for competition a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership; or handle a dog at the Show at which they are judging. Dogs may be disqualified if proved to have been handled in the class by the scheduled judge's spouse or immediate family, or resident at the same address as the scheduled judge.
17. Removal of dogs from Competition: Following discussion between the show management and/or a veterinary surgeon, a dog shall be prevented from competing or removed from the Show if it is:
 - A. A bitch which is in season.
 - B. Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease.
 - C. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
 - D. Of such temperament or is so much out of control as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal
 - E. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.

The circumstances of such a removal shall be recorded in the competition/show Incident Book.

18. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 25 days before the start of the competition, i.e. **(1st February 2018)** shall be counted when entering for any class. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule. In the event that a dog becomes eligible for the next grade at a particular show, after the entry for that show has been sent, it is the competitor's responsibility to notify the show secretary at least 14 days before the date of the show. The dog will then be moved into the appropriate class(es) for the next grade. The dog must be moved into the corresponding number of classes as were entered at the lower grade.
19. In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the society will refund fees, less reasonably incurred expenses. If the show processor has the provisions to do so, competitors will be refunded in the manner in which they had entered the show, but in any event the society will refund fees within 3 months of the show date to all those who had entered and requested a refund within 1 month of the show date.
20. Dog Agility is a competitive and physically strenuous activity. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to ensure their dog is 'fit for function' and that they themselves are fit to take part. By signing the entry form you confirm that to the best of your knowledge your dog is fit and able to take part in Agility classes on the day of the show.
21. Except for mobility aids or silent toys, nothing shall be carried in the hand while the dog is under test and food shall not be given to a dog whilst in the ring.
22. Should the judge deem a re-run is required, any result and/or faults gained in the previous run must be discounted.
23. Separate entry forms must be completed by each owner and must signed by the owner or his authorised agent in accordance with provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied by the appropriate fees.
24. Competition of Dogs Suffering from Contagious or Infectious Disease – No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Competition may compete.
25. It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class and running order. Competitors must run as close to their running order as possible.
26. **Animals in Event** No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the General Committee. However, at the discretion of the show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.

Welfare of Dogs: An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this regulation may result in that competitor being asked to leave the show. **DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS** Your dog is vulnerable and **AT RISK** if left in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for damage caused.

CHILDREN UNDER 16: The duty of care remains with the parent(s) or other accompanying responsible adult(s) at all times.
